

Project Deliverable 3: Context Diagram

Having prepared a system description outlining the main elements of the system you are modeling, the next step is to define the scope and boundaries of the system model, that is, the elements of the overall system that will be included in the model and those elements that will not be explicitly modeled. This can be done using a context diagram, as described in the course lecture associated with this deliverable.

Your context diagram should use the terms, definitions, and descriptions from your system description deliverable. If the process of creating the context diagram reveals gaps or contradictions in the system description, these inconsistencies should be corrected in the system description before completing this deliverable.

It is recommended that the context diagram be prepared using Microsoft Visio. Your instructor will show you how to obtain a license to use this software for this project.

Prepare your deliverable as a PowerPoint presentation that you will present to the class on the deliverable due date. Upload your presentation to the appropriate D2L discussion forum by 5:00 PM on the due date.
